Children entering kindergarten in the fall of 2020 should be age 5 on or before September 1, 2020.

Residents of the Waverly Community Schools must provide the following:

- State certified birth certificate
- Current immunization record or waiver from the Health Department
- One proof of residency (current utility bill or turn on notice, lease agreement, mortgage document, property tax bill)
- A vision and hearing screening result
- Additional items (helpful but not required) that are specific to your student:

Special Education documents, court orders regarding guardianship, and medical information.

Kindergarten Vision/Hearing Testing:

June 9 and August 4, 2020

All incoming kindergartners for the 2020-2021 school year are required to have a vision and hearing screening before the 1st day of school. A vision and hearing screening can be obtained by:

- Your child's health care provider
- FREE vision and hearing screenings will be offered on June 9th and August 4th at the Waverly Administrative Center at 515 Snow Rd., Lansing. The FREE screening will be performed by our local Health Department technicians. Each appointment only takes about 15 minutes. Please sign up at:
