
The Waverly Education Foundation was established in 1993 as a result of the Superintendent's School Business Partnership Committee chaired by Dr. Jon Reynolds. Its goal was to establish an alternative funding source for teachers. An initial \$10,000 grant was presented to the newly formed Foundation by Ms. Susan Steiner Bolhouse. These dollars were not spent on the new organization but were invested to create the Foundation's endowment fund. The purpose of the Foundation was to create and grow an independent funding source that would benefit students of the Waverly Community Schools when normal school funding was not available. Teachers would apply for grants to support projects that encourage academic progress and enhance the educational environment.

Today, annual grant applications submitted by Waverly staff and students are funded by individuals, businesses, and memberships in our President's Club. The Foundation's two significant annual events (the Meijer Team Golf Scramble and the Gala Event) are important fundraisers intended to help our trustees grow the endowment fund, which is valued today at over \$250,000.
